RESOLUTION # 11:13/14
DECLARING HEALTH CARE WEEK IN KING CITY
WEEK OF MARCH 2, 2014**

WHEREAS, The Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act was enacted in 2010 to increase the number of Americans with health insurance; and,

WHEREAS, Covered California is the doorway to the state's new marketplace for individuals and their families to purchase health insurance; and,

WHEREAS, 5.3 million Californians are eligible to purchase coverage through the exchange, with 2.6 million Californians able to receive premium assistance by the federal government to help buy health coverage; and

WHEREAS, Covered California is the only place where South Monterey County residents can obtain premium assistance from the federal government to reduce their health insurance costs; and

WHEREAS, California has also expanded its Medi-Cal program, allowing more individuals who meet certain criteria to be eligible for Medi-Cal health insurance; and

WHEREAS, eligibility for Medi-Cal can also be determined through California's exchange; and

WHEREAS, South Monterey County residents will be able to purchase private health insurance with a guaranteed set of essential benefits that does not exclude individuals with pre-existing conditions; and

WHEREAS, the open enrollment period in California for health coverage offered through Covered California closes on March 31, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the King City Community will host a series of educational and enrollment events through a partnership between the City of King, Mee Memorial Hospital, area Churches, South Monterey County Joint Union High School District, King City Union School District, King City Chamber of Commerce & Agriculture, Covered California Certified Insurance Agents, and the Monterey Bay Central Labor Council; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that by the adoption of this Resolution, the South Monterey County Joint Union High School District declares the week of March 2nd as Health Care Week in King City and will fully support and collaborate with Covered California to help residents obtain health coverage through the exchange.
