Summary:

Migrant students are graduating from high school at a lower rate than other non-migrant students (based on data collected from DataQuest), therefore the Migrant Program will provide services to ensure that students are aware of the A-G requirements. In the 2017 2018 State Service Delivery Plan for Migrant Students CDE has approved the College and Career Readiness Service. In order to close the achievement gap for migrant students the MEP must expose students to STEM careers.

There will be 10 students traveling to Fremont. The goal is to code for 24 hours, the students will produce a product. They will be sleeping in sleeping bags at the actual location. Students will not be in individual rooms; they will be supervised by Migrant staff.

The students will depart on Saturday, November 11 at 8:00 AM and return Sunday, November 12 at 4:00 PM.

Recommendation:

It is recommended that the Board of Education approve the Migrant Students trip to Fremont for Code Day.

Fiscal Impact:

There is no fiscal impact to the district. Migrant Education Region XVII will cover all of the cost associated with the trip.

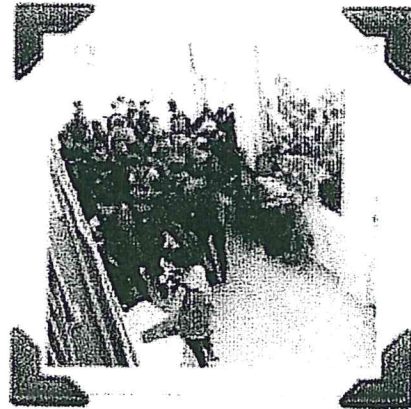
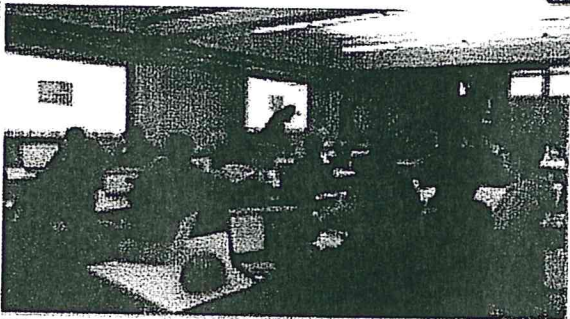
