Public Content

Summary

Dashboard Alternative School Status (DASS)

California Education Code (EC) Section 52052(d) requires: *The Superintendent, with the approval of the State Board of Education, shall develop an alternative accountability system for*

schools under the jurisdiction of a county board of education or a county superintendent of schools, community day schools, . . . and alternative schools serving high-risk pupils, including continuation high schools and opportunity schools . . .

Under the state eligibility criteria, Pinnacle Academy Charter (PAC) qualifies for this form of alternative accountability system. 97% of students enrolled with PAC fall within the eligibility criteria.

Over the course of the past two years, Pinnacle enrollment has shifted to a high at-risk population of students whom are vulnerable to dropping out. The population consists of either teens who are pregnant or parenting, expulsion, 5th year seniors, habitually truant or student who are on truancy probation, anxiety and/or depressed students (doctors notes are provided), students with high level transiency and/or homeless youth. Therefore, it is necessary that PAC should shift from the traditional accountability system to an alternative method of accountability, which provides a clearer representation of our academic progress.
