Bruce Corbett said most of the information was gathered from previous year and before his employment with the district. Dr. Bernard commented the physical fitness information was not available from the state until today. This information will be inserted before it goes to the website.

Mike Foster commented there is a lot of information regarding student achievement.

Debra McAlahney-Dodson questioned what should we as the Board be looking at. The information seems to be a broad over view. Mr. Foster said he just wants to understand the flow.

Dr. Bernard said parents do compare these school reports when they are considering relocating and picking a new home. Originally it was a 3 or 4 page report and the state use to complete the information, it is now compiled by the districts and has now expanded.

Mike Foster said he would like to have a study session to see how we are going to use the information. Dr. Bernard said this may be combined with the Student Achievement study session scheduled May 22.

Debra McAlahney-Dodson asked if the data is automated, if not, it may be a goal for the district because a lot of information needs to be compiled. She also commented with information from the school safety plans are we arming the administration and teachers with what is needed. Do the other systems gather the data?

Quentin Panek said there is a lot of cutting and pasting in completing the report. In the past the state did submit approximately one third of the data, which the principal is now doing. There are other sources where information is gathered. Debra McAlahney-Dodson suggested automating the information in the future.

Dr. Bernard asked Mr. Corbett how long it took him to complete the report, his response was 7 to 8 hours because it had to be extracted from different places.

Dr. Bernard approved the SARC Report for King City High School.

**b. Approval of Candy Butler Continuation High School (Portola-Butler) 2009-2010 SARC Report****Minutes:**

Carolyn McCombs said she had to create her report because a previous report had not been completed. She added basically she went through the same process as Mr. Corbett. It is just time consuming gathering the information. Next time the report will be easier since the information has now been compiled.

Dr. Bernard approved the Candy Butler (Portola-Butler) SARC Report.

### **c. Approval of Greenfield High School 2009-2010 SARC Report**

Having the information automated in other areas is a good, otherwise it would be extremely cumbersome.

Dr. Bernard said corrections would be made before it is posted on our website. The comment was added, if the answer is a percentage to make sure the percentage sign is behind the number.
